JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE FEDERATED STATES OF MICRONESIA AND THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA

The Government of the Federated States of Micronesia and the Government of the Republic of Lithuania,

Desirous to sustain and to strengthen the friendly relations between their two States in the mutual interest of their peoples;

Interested in promoting and intensifying cooperation between their two States in the political, economic and cultural domain;

Guided by the principles of international law, the goals and objectives of the United Nations Organization, particularly as regards to the need to preserve international peace and security, and respect for equality among States, national sovereignty, independence, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations between the Federated States of Micronesia and the Republic of Lithuania in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961.

Done in New York, on 4 November 2013, in duplicate in the English and Lithuanian languages, both texts being equally authentic.
