INSTRUMENT OF ACCESSION

WHEREAS, the International Convention for the Suppression of Terrorist Bombing ("the Convention") was adopted by Resolution A/RES/52/164 of the General Assembly of the United Nations on December 15, 1997;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article 21 of the Convention, the Convention is open to accession by any Member of the United Nations;

WHEREAS, the Twelfth Congress of the Federated States of Micronesia adopted Congressional Resolution No. 12-38 on January 30, 2002 acceding to the Convention;

NOW THEREFORE, I, the Acting Secretary of Foreign Affairs of the Federated States of Micronesia, hereby execute this Instrument of Accession on this 14th day of March, 2002, and direct that it be deposited with the Secretary-General of the United Nations forthwith.
